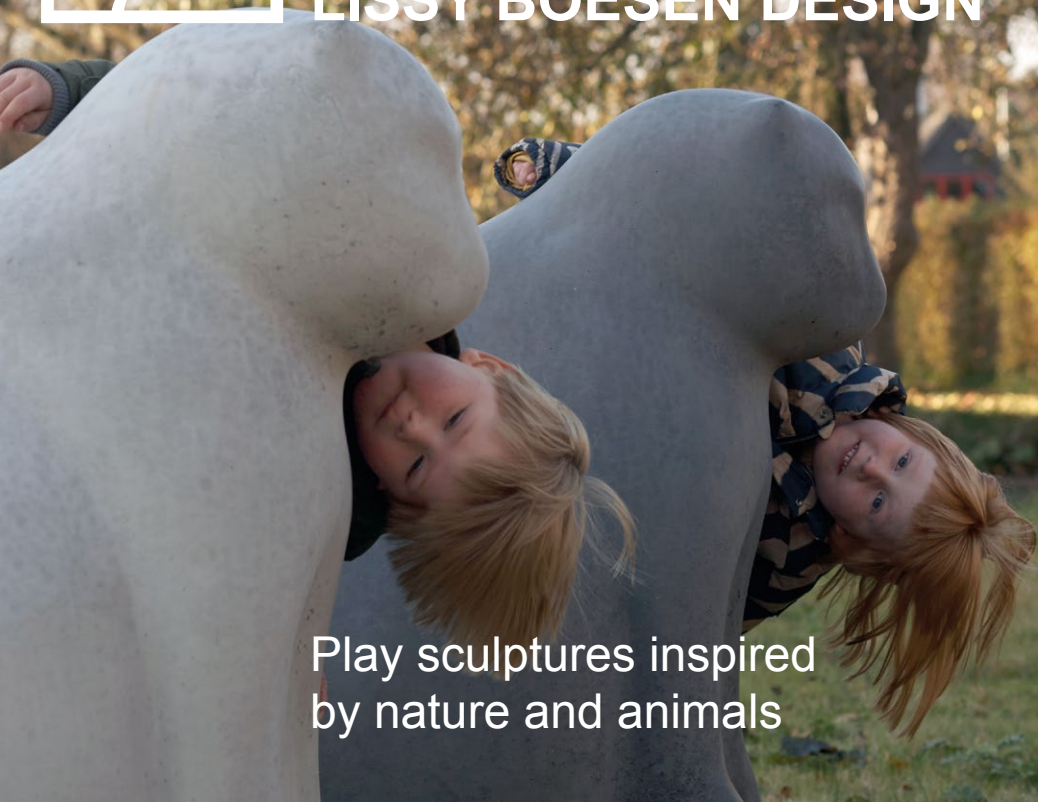

Play sculptures for nature and urban space

Lissy Boesen Design has created play sculptures for country and city since 1985, placed on everything from playgrounds, squares, pedestrian streets to indoor shopping centers and hospitals. The sculptures are not only beautiful to look at, but invite play and imagination.

For Lissy, the cat is a beautiful and fascinating creature with a serene nature. It's almost as if it knows how to arrange its body so that it looks the best it can. With such an obvious 'model', it is hardly a coincidence that it was precisely the cat that was the first to be immortalised.

Welcome to a world where art is not just nice for the eye, but where it is encouraged to be touched, sat on and played with.

Play sculptures everywhere

You can find Lissy Boesen's work on squares and pedestrian streets, in parks, hospitals, playgrounds, residential area, shopping centres and...

A special, fully pigmented concrete is used for casting the sculptures, which does not erode and which gives a smooth and 'soft' surface that is nice to touch. It becomes almost impossible to keep your fingers off the 'stroking stone'.

Lissy Boesen has combined both the function of sitting and playing in the sculpture into one beautiful unit.

The sculptures are made of coloured concrete and can withstand the outdoors all year round. Over the years, they age with a beautiful patina surface – just like the rest of us.

From idea to sculpture

The process of creating a new sculpture begins with calm contemplation; an observation of animal behavior, a series of sketches on paper and in clay. It is the love of the process that is reflected in the finished product.

The small models gradually take shape and are polished until they reach the rounded simplicity and soft surface that is characteristic of Lissy's expression. Finally one of the sketches are chosen for an upscaling and further pre-production.



Becoming part of the herd

Much of the animal kingdom has been depicted. Some of them develop into a sculpture, others stand a bit in the background and are brought to the fore after many years. So there are many animals that hibernate until they possibly become part of the herd.

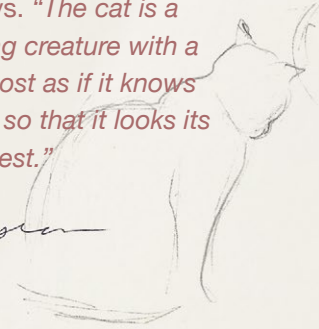


The cat

The concrete sculptures are highly attributed to the joy and appreciation of one particular animal: the cat, which with its graceful movements, calm nature and wayward personality appeals to both her imagination and emotions.

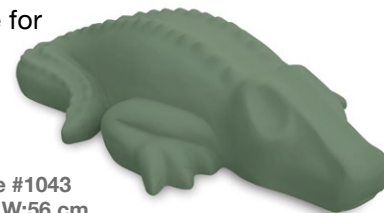
Around the world












